- Hayden Hanover finished second to Stay Hungry in his Pace elimination at 5-1. He drew post seven which is three for 41 in Pace Finals.
- Hayden Hanover came into his Pace elimination first time Lasix and had finished a close second to American History in a sizzling 1:47 on June 29.
- Although winless as a sophomore Hayden Hanover advanced to the North America Cup Final and was no factor finishing in ninth from post nine.
- Hayden Hanover took his mark of 1:50 in a division of the International Stallion Stake at the Red Mile as a freshman, and finished second in both the Pennsylvania Sires Stakes Championship and Metro Final.
- Julie Miller maintained her Top 10 presence at the Meadowlands during the 2016-17 meet, posted a career best \$4,679,554 million season with 138 wins, and continued to build a strong reputation with trotters. Julie and her husband Andy Miller had a pair of three-year-olds well on the road to the 2017 Hambletonian, Fly On and Devious Man, and the latter finished third, placed second in the \$1 million final. On the filly side, Overdraft Volo won a division of the Del Miller Memorial in 1:52.2. The Millers can look forward to 2018 with two-year-old Breeders Crown runner ups Met's Hall and Seviyorum.
- Andy Miller enjoyed his best season in five years in 2017 with 316 wins and almost \$6 million (\$5,880,861). Miller finished sixth in the Big M driver standings with 60 wins. He passed the 8,800-win mark and \$116 million. On Pace night, he won a division of the Del Miller Memorial with Overdraft Volo. Andy and his wife Julie were third placed second in the Hambletonian Final with Devious Man, and they have another prospect for 2018 in Breeders Crown runner up Met's Hall. Andy also ran away with his first driving title at Freehold Raceway. His best finish was a second in his Pace debut in 2006 with My Boy David.
- His super sire the late Somebeachsomewhere suffered his only career loss in 21 starts in the 2008 Pace when he was upset by Art Official in a world record 1:47. From his first crop, the 2008 Horse of the Year sired 2013 Pace winner and Tony Alagna trainee Captaintreacherous, whose own first crop have been outstanding this season. He sired the one-two finishers in last year's Pace, Huntsville and Downbytheseaside. He sent out seven of the 15 in last week's eliminations and five advanced to the final, including elimination winner Stay Hungry.
- His dam Hana Hanover [\$1,206,664] was a 2008 Breeders Crown winner at the Meadowlands in 1:48.4.
- Co-owner and Hall of Famer James Simpson is the President of Hanover Shoe Farms, the largest Standardbred Breeder in the world. After leading the industry for 69 straight years, his nursery set an all-time record of \$31 million in 2017.
